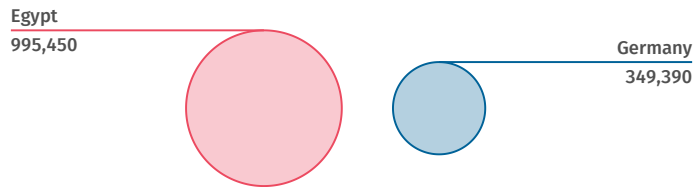

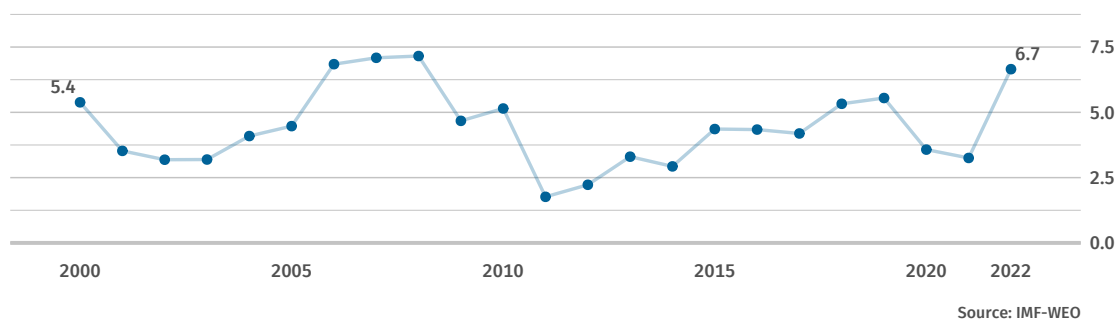

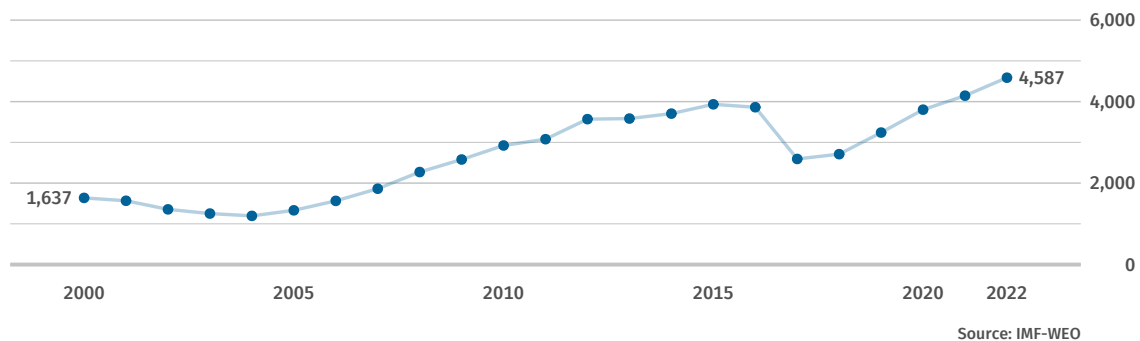

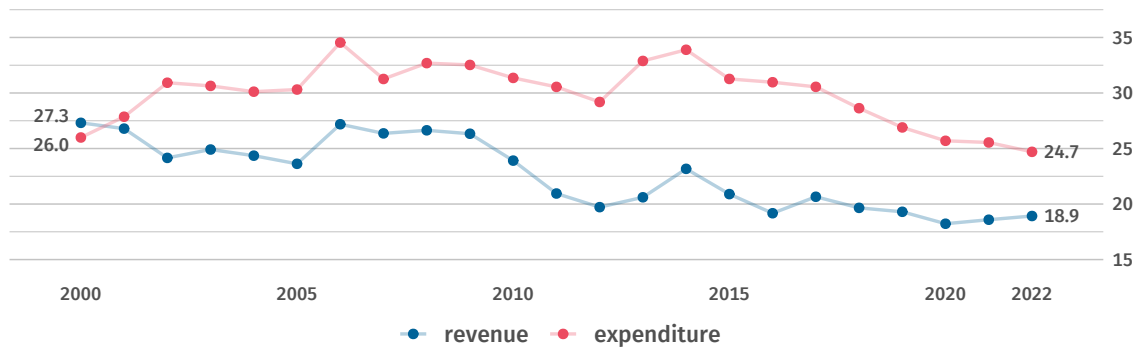

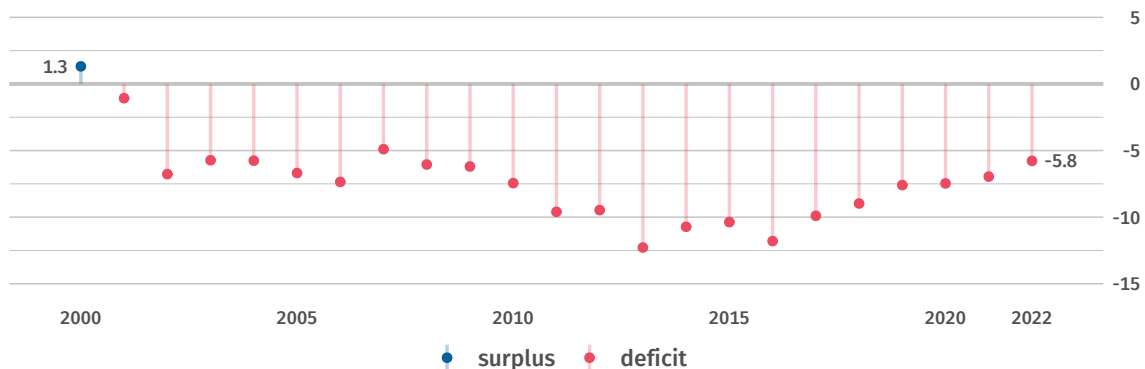

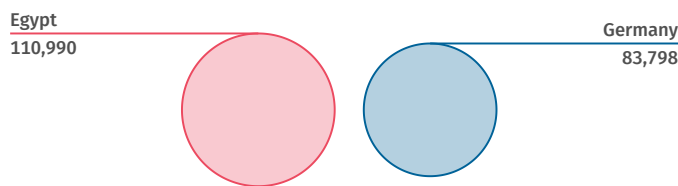

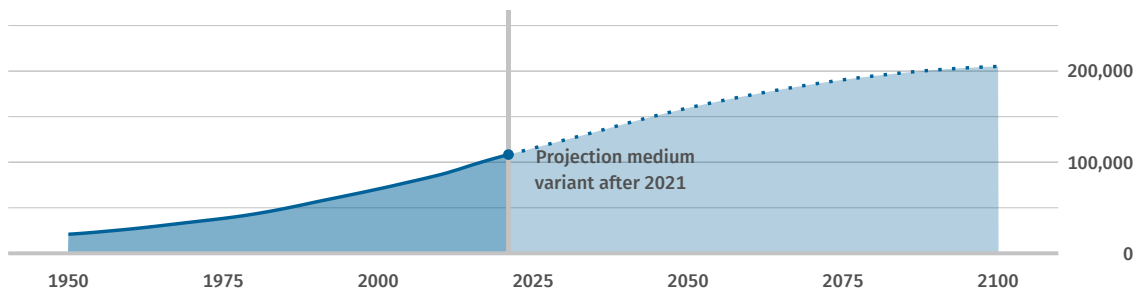

Population in relation to Germany 2022 1,000



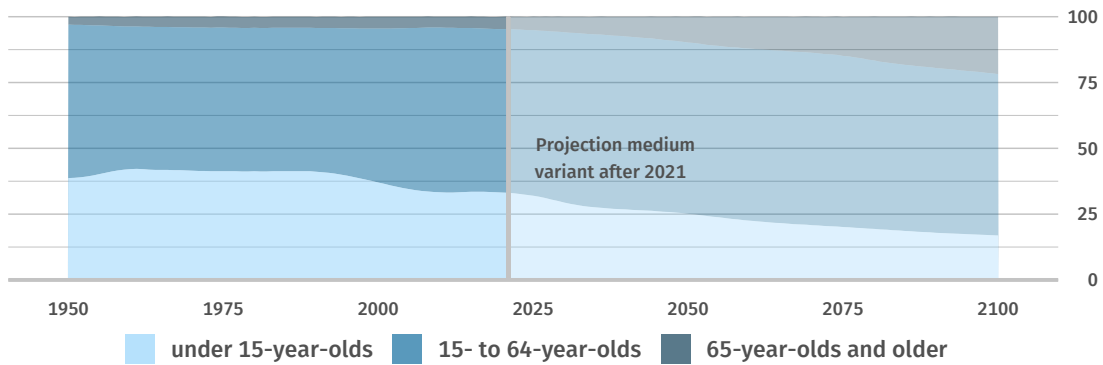

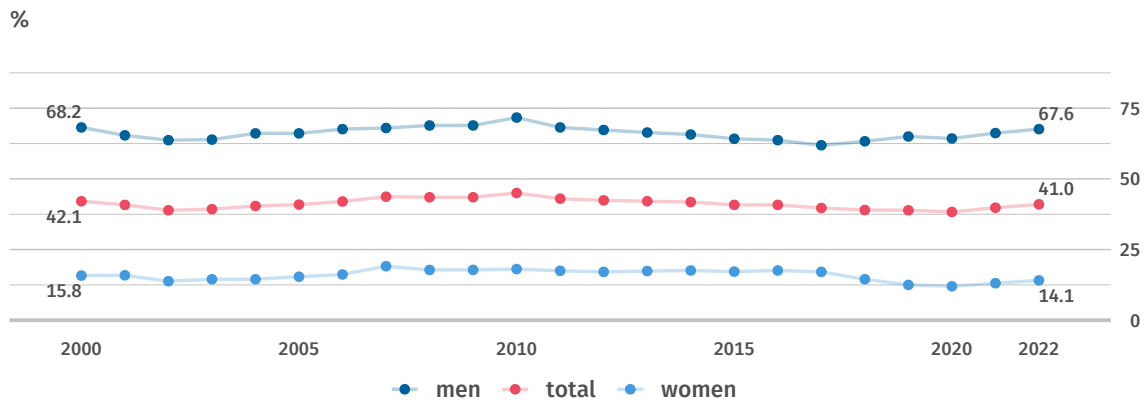

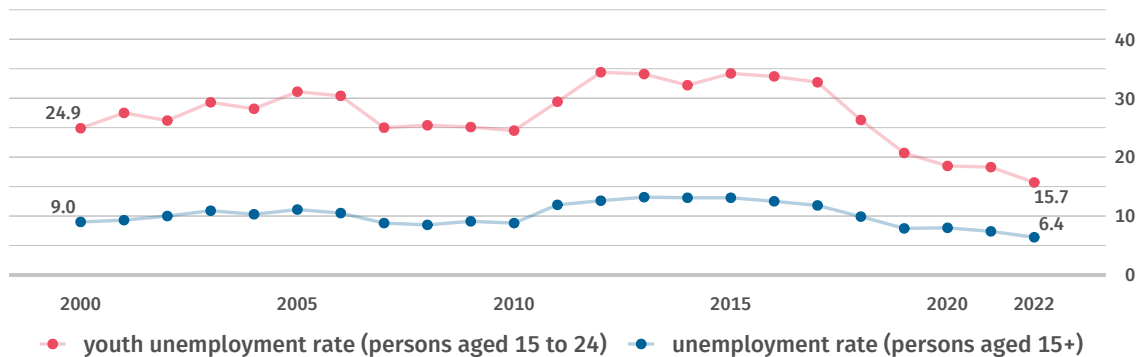

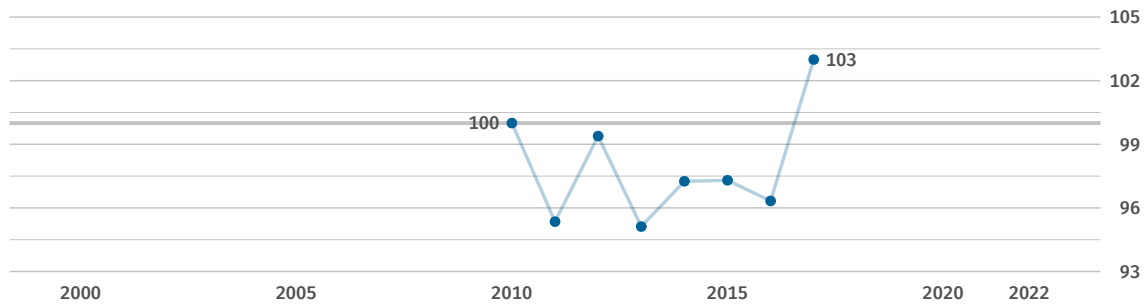

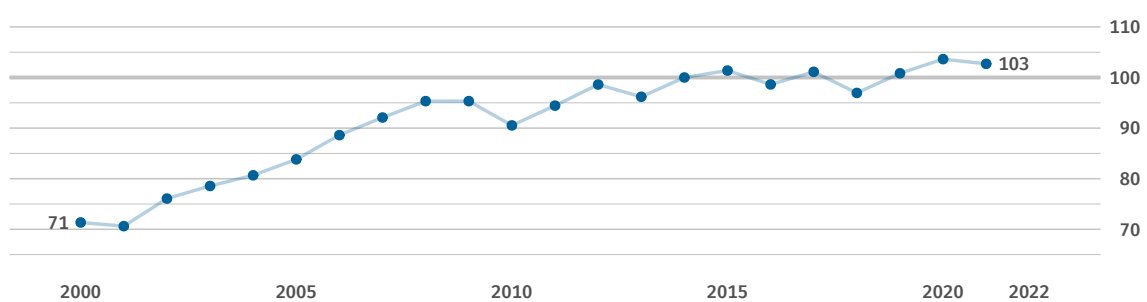

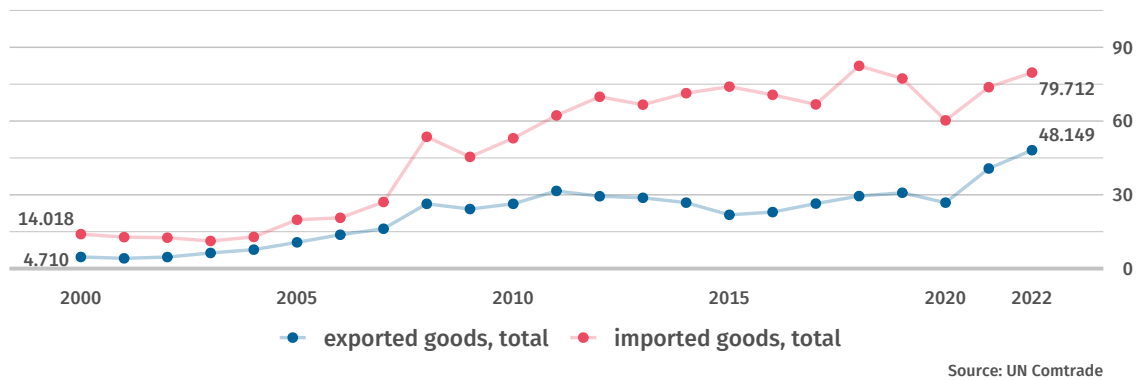

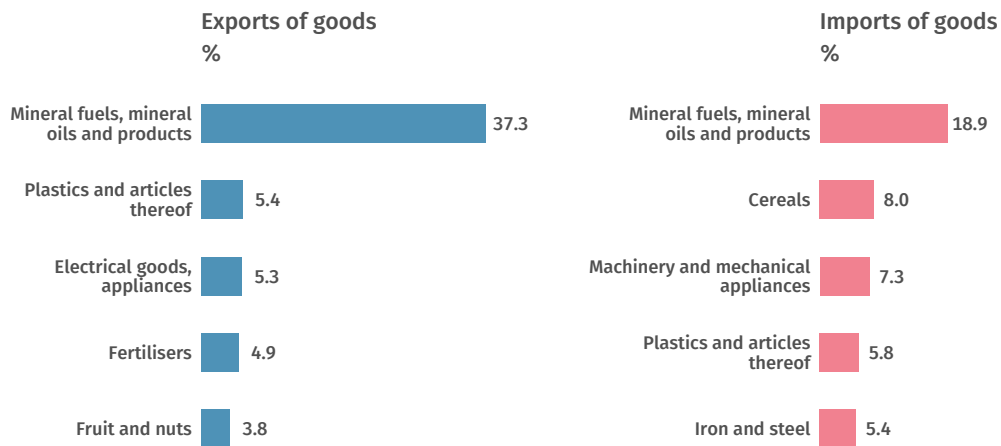

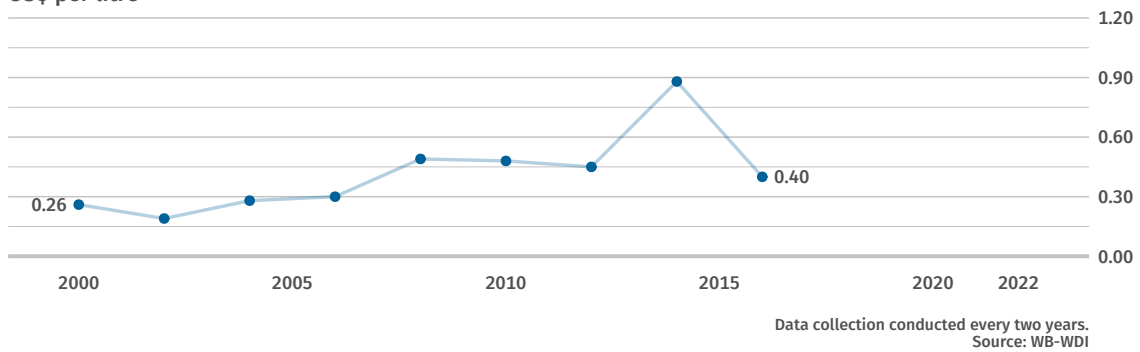

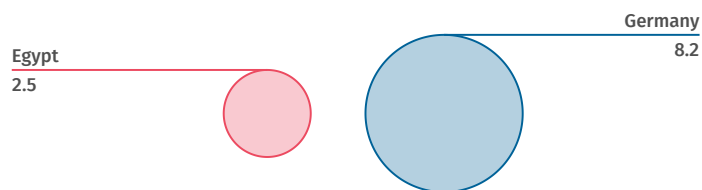
Gasoline price at the pump US\$ per litre

Carbon dioxide emissions in relation to Germany 2022 tonnes per capita



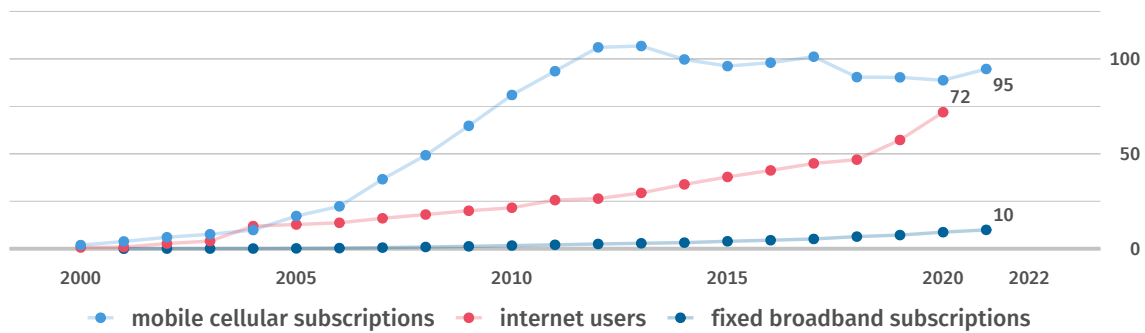
